EPA Priority Activity

Proper CMOM of Collection Systems

(**C**apacity, **M**anagement, **O**perations, **M**aintenance)

- Evaluate 100% of CSs with treatment capacity of >100 MGD and 30% of their satellites; and
- Evaluate 50% of CSs with treatment capacity >10MGD, <100 MGD and 30% of their satellites;

Ensuring Deficiencies Addressed

FOG Control in Collection Systems

- Recent data shows over 65% of spills nationwide caused by FOG sources
- California – General WDR addresses FOG through requirement for FOG plan
- EPA – FOG program reviews as part of O&M evaluation to focus on IMPLEMENTATION of program

Elements of FOG Review

- Coordination within (among) agency(ies)
- Targetting
- Record keeping
- Inspection
- Enforcement
